

Founded in 2011, the Huntsville Theatre Company is committed to providing year-round live theatre in the Muskoka area. We are a community theatre production group which means that our performers and production teams are volunteering their time to create exceptional productions. The HTC is devoted to creating opportunities for the members of the community to develop skills in all aspects of theatre production.

Community theatre is a pillar of skill development at any age. The HTC believes community theatre is the most effective space to foster creativity, community spirit and honest support between people. Muskoka has a rich and expansive creative community from actors to musicians to designers. There is a wealth of talent who participates in our incredible seasons of performances.

This year's programming consists of six main season shows running from October until August, a free after school youth program that runs from February until June, monthly one-night immersive dance events, and eclectic summer music-based performances.
